RESOLUTION FOR APPOINTMENT OF TOWNSHIP CLERK TO FILL VACANCY

Adopted by the
Board of Trustees of
Mahomet Township
this 10th day of January, 2026

WHEREAS, Mahomet Township, Champaign County, Illinois (hereinafter "Township") is a "Public Body" under the Illinois Open Meetings Act 5 ILCS 120/1 et. seq.;

WHEREAS, the former Mahomet Township Clerk, Christi Lagle, who was elected as the Township Clerk with a term which runs through the fall 2028 election cycle, resigned from the Clerk position, dated on January 6, 2026, which was accepted by the Board of Trustees on January 10, 2026;

WHEREAS, Section 60-5(a) of the Illinois Township Code [**60 ILCS 1/60-5(a)**] provides that the Township Board of Trustees shall fill such vacancy by appointment of a new Township Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the Township heretofore adopts this Resolution to appoint Rebecca Heid as the new Mahomet Township Clerk, to serve the remainder of Christi Lagle's elected term through the fall 2028 election cycle.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Board of Trustees of Mahomet Township, Champaign County, Illinois, as follows:

1. **Appointment of Clerk to Fill Vacancy.** The Board of Trustees hereby accepts the resignation of Christi Lagle and hereby appoints Rebecca Heid as the new Mahomet Township Clerk, to fill the vacancy and serve the remainder of Christi Lagle's elected term through the fall 2028 election cycle.
2. **Effective Date.** This Resolution shall be in full force and effective immediately from and after its passage, and approval as provided by law.

Upon motion by Trustee Aaron Wheeler, seconded by Trustee Matt Howard, and passed by the President and Board of Trustees of Mahomet Township, on this 10th day of January, 2026, by roll call vote as follows:


