I would like to know why all bills direct debited or paid with your debit card from the Township are not included in the bills presented to trustees or posted online? Such as your adobe, YouTube tv, web services, fuel, car washes etc. Why are you hiding where some of the Township money is going and being spent on?

I have looked at your tentative budget and I have more questions. You have a contingency line item in the amount of \$174,183. In township budgets, a contingency line item can be no more than 5% of that fund. Your contingency line item 22% of the town fund – that is \$135,250 over the limit. Also, you cannot spend from a contingency line item. You must move the money to a specific line item before spending it. So, you are going to have to make a budget amendment to spend that money. The max allowed on that line according to your tentative budget is roughly \$38,000. And limits on budget amendments are 10% of line item without doing a public hearing. So, each time you could only move \$3800. Why not designate those funds to a line item now instead of having to do budget amendments or just incorrectly spending that money.

You have \$179,500 budgeted for cemetery expenses and only levy \$84,026 before tax caps are applied. How long can the cemetery fund last with expenses twice as much as tax income?

I would like to suggest you take another look at your past spending and make appropriate changes to your budget and rethink the contingency line item.
